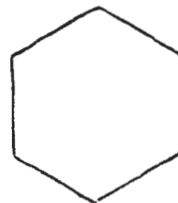


Trace dashed line (circle) onto background fabric with a 'removable' marker
(This is to align your hexagons on)

Trace stitchery design onto background fabric using your usual method for transferring
stitchery design (e.g. Tan, fine-point, permanent marker, or HB pencil).



Trace hexagon shape onto thin cardboard and cut out. You will need 12 hexagon templates.
(or use pre-cut 1/2" hexagon papers)



Method

Cut out 12 fabric hexagons, add a 1/4" seam for appliqué or EPP.

My hexagons are individual fussy cut flowers, you could use a stripe or other motif in its place.

Glue or thread baste the fabric to the paper.

Create a circle by stitching the points of the hexagons together; remove paper.

Place them on the edge of the 3" circle and appliqué in place.

You can add the embroidery design before or after stitching the hexagons.

Print at 100% size, to fit a 6" finished block.
